

- I. Call to Order
- II. Pledge Allegiance to the Flag
- III. Roll Call
 - a. Present: Tim Yocum, RJ Dunavan, and Britton Luther
- IV. Election of Officers
 - a. A motion is made by Luther to elect Yocum as president and Dunavan as Vice President and seconded by Dunavan. All in favor, motion carried.
- V. Approval of Memorandum
 - a. A motion was made by Dunavan to approve the December 21st and December 28th meeting memorandums, and it was seconded by Luther. All in favor, motion carried.
- VI. Approval of Claims
 - a. A motion was made by Luther to approve the January 7th claims, and it was seconded by Dunavan. All in favor, motion carried.
- VII. Approval of Payroll
 - a. A motion was made by Dunavan to approve the January 7th payroll, and it was seconded by Luther. All in favor, motion carried.
- VIII. Treasurer's Report


