- I. **CALL TO ORDER.** The Vermillion County Commissioner's convened in a regular meeting on Tuesday, December 29, 2015. South Vermillion High School Senior, Taylor Mackey assisted in opening and calling the meeting to order. Mackey led the pledge of allegiance.
- II. **ROLL CALL.** Members present were President Tim Wilson, Vice-President Harry Crossley, Tim Yocum, Auditor Phyllis Orman, and Attorney Jon Spurr.
- III. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**. The minutes from December 15, 2015were approved on a motion made by Harry Crossley and seconded by Tim Yocum. The motion carried.
- IV. **EXAMINATION OF CLAIMS.** After reviewing the claims docket, the claims were approved for release on January 1, 2016 on a motion by Harry Crossley and seconded by Tim Yocum. The motion carried.
- V. **EXAMINATION OF PAYROLL.** After reviewing the payroll docket, the payroll was approved for release on January 1, 2016 on a motion by Harry Crossley and seconded by Tim Yocum. The motion carried.
- VI. **MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT.** Wilson acknowledged receipt of the monthly financial report.

- Hunting on county owned property. Tabled.

- 2016 Appointments. Crossley made a motion to keep the appointments that same as last year, seconded by Yocum. Motion carried. Crossley mentioned that Greg Looney replaced Miller on the APC and BZA boards and that Ronald Finger has replaced Tom Wilks on the e911 board.
- Bridge 122. Yocum said that bridge 122 was inspected and some work needs done. Crossley said it will need put out for bid and they need to check the funds because Cumulative Bridge's budget was cut for 2016. Yocum said the work needs done and that the bridge, which is on old 63 is the biggest in the county.
- High water barricades. Wilson wanted to remind everyone to not ignore the barricades. He said they are put out for a reason and that by removing them or going around them could put someone's life in danger.
